

## **National Panhellenic Conference Foundation, Inc. Donor Bill of Rights**

To merit the respect and trust of the alumnae and collegiate Greek community and the general public, and to instill confidence in its friends and supporters, the NPC Foundation declares that its donors have the right to:

- I. Be informed of the Foundation's mission and vision, and of its philanthropic purposes, and to be assured of its capacity to use donors' gifts wisely and effectively.
- II. Be assured that donor's gifts will be used only for the purposes for which they were given.
- III. Be informed of the composition of the Board of Trustees, and to expect the Board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- IV. Have access to the Foundation's financial statements.
- V. Receive appropriate acknowledgement of their gifts and recognition of themselves as supporters.
- VI. Be assured that gift and donor information will be handled with discretion and confidentiality, and in compliance with the law.
- VII. Expect that all relationships with donors and others will be professional in nature.
- VIII. Be informed whether those in contact with them to seek support for the Foundation are volunteers, employees, or hired solicitors.
- IX. Be assured that the Foundation will not share names with other organizations for mailing purposes.
- X. Expect thorough discourse when making a gift, to feel comfortable asking questions, and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
