Preamble

The National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) is the premier advocacy and support organization for the advancement of the sorority experience. As such, NPC monitors national issues and legislation that impacts it and its 26 member organizations; NPC encourages civic engagement from our members. We call on sorority women to display courage and conviction in their support of our core principles and to advocate for issues related to three legislative pillars that comprise the NPC government relations agenda.

Pillar One: Preservation of the sorority experience

- Protect and defend our rights to operate and exist as single-gender organizations
- Protect and defend our freedom of association
- Monitor actions that threaten due process rights for organizations

Pillar Two: Financial parity and college affordability

- Support the Collegiate Housing Infrastructure Act (CHIA)
- Support efforts to preserve the current value of charitable deductions
- Monitor issues related to college affordability

Pillar Three: Student and campus safety

- Support CHIA
- Support efforts to discourage and prevent college/university designation of collegiate students, alumnae volunteers and sorority employees as Clery Act campus security authorities (CSAs) and mandatory reporters under Title IX legislation
- Monitor campus safety issues affecting our sorority women and all students
- Encourage efforts to promote sexual assault awareness
