April ...The Month to Celebrate Those Who Support and Mentor Your Campus Panhellenic!

During the month of April, the National Panhellenic Conference encourages our members to recognize and celebrate the many professionals and volunteers who support our collegiate chapters, our College Panhellenics and our fraternity/sorority communities. How will your campus recognize your advisors?

Celebrate as a College Panhellenic:

- Send certificates of appreciation to all chapter advisors and staff.
- Place an ad in your campus newspaper recognizing all those who advise, guide and support our fraternity/sorority communities.
- Feature National Advisor Appreciation Month on your College Panhellenic website.
- Ask a local spa if they would provide discounts one day during the month for all those you recognize; use coupons enclosed with letters of appreciation to distribute to your chapter advisors, campus administrators and community leaders.
- If your campus has chapter facilities with kitchens, sponsor a progressive dinner for your chapter advisors and College Panhellenic administrative staff.
- Provide babysitting for advisors who have children so they can have a "date" night.
- Sponsor a month-long chapter penny drive to raise funds to donate in honor of your advisors to your foundation, the <u>NPC Foundation</u> or a university foundation.
- At a chapter meeting, divide into your committees to write thank you notes and notes
 of appreciation to your advisors.
- Send a <u>letter to the editor</u> of your campus and local newspapers explaining why you appreciate all those who support your College Panhellenic community.
- Ask your college/university president to declare an Advisor Appreciation Day.
