



About the Women in Higher Education Achievement Award

NOMINATION MUST BE SUBMITTED [ONLINE](#) BY JUNE 1

Nominations are being sought for the 2021 Women in Higher Education Achievement (WHEA) Award.

The WHEA Award recognizes an outstanding woman who has made or is making a significant difference in higher education through her scholarship and leadership. Her contributions may be in the area of faculty, staff or administration at a college, university or community college or they may be through association with a professional education association or government entity that promotes higher education. She has a positive attitude toward the value of the sorority experience, and she may or may not be a member of a Greek-letter organization.

The recipient of this award will be invited to attend and make a short presentation at the next NPC annual conference. Her expenses will be covered and she will receive an honorarium of \$1,000.

The NPC Foundation is organized to promote values and ethics in sororities and to encourage members to be active and responsible leaders in their respective communities through the development and sponsorship of educational and charitable programs to address education, leadership, health and safety.

The WHEA Award is funded by the NPC Foundation through an endowment established by Sigma Sigma Sigma Sorority and the Foundation.

The application information/responses will be automatically saved and may be continuously updated until your final submission. (Note: NPC uses SmarterSelect to collect application information online. If you do not have a SmarterSelect account, you will need to take a few moments to create an account before beginning the application.)

APPLICATION

1. Nominee's education and profession: Upload a resume or CV for your nominee.
2. Nominee's education and profession: Describe the professional accomplishments of the nominee in the past five years.
3. Publication of nominee's work: Provide a website link to a publication credited to the nominee OR upload a file with the publication that is credited to the nominee.
4. Letter of support: Provide a letter of support that describes the nominee's positive attitude toward the values of the sorority experience. Give examples.
