

About the Outstanding Panhellenic Advisor Award Application

APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY JUNE 1

Each biennium, the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) recognizes an outstanding Panhellenic advisor. To be eligible for the award, the individual must meet the following:

- Have served a minimum of five years as a Panhellenic advisor, with at least two years at current institution.
- Oversee a College Panhellenic that adheres to all NPC Unanimous Agreements.
- Promote harmony and a positive Panhellenic image.
- Follow ethical practices in membership recruitment.
- Communicate with the NPC College Panhellenic area advisor regularly.
- Communicate with inter/national organizations when appropriate.

For an advisor to be recognized by NPC, the application must be received <u>online</u>. The application information/responses will be automatically saved and may be continuously updated until your final submission.

Below are the questions on the award application for your reference. If you need assistance answering the questions and do not want to let the advisor know that he or she is being nominated, consider asking his/her supervisor or another member of the department where he or she works on campus.

- 3. Beyond what is stated above, please describe how the advisor has encouraged positive change within the fraternity and sorority community.
- 4. Please list any organizations the advisor belongs to and any volunteer roles he or she holds within those associations.
- 5. Explain how the advisor serves as a role model and maintains a professional manner regarding College Panhellenic concerns.
- 6. In your own words, please describe why you believe the nominee deserves this award.
