



2018-19 Annual Survey Highlights: Fast Facts

Data submitted by National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) member organizations

Membership

Size and scope

- 26 member organizations report a total of 5,385,038 women currently initiated into our organizations. This represents a 2.5 percent increase from last year.
- 25 member organizations report 3,889,102 living alumnae representing a 4.9 percent increase.
- 26 member organizations report 384,298 total undergraduates.* This represents a 4.2 percent decrease from the last academic year.
- 26 member organizations report 3,349 collegiate chapters and colonies (14 colonies representing ten member organizations). This is down 0.09 percent from 3,352 chapters last year.**
 - 26 member organizations report 26 chapters were chartered in 2018-19. This represents a 35 percent decrease from the last academic year.
- 26 member organizations report 3,536 alumnae chapters currently.

Retention

- 26 member organizations report 144,598 women were pledged into membership during the 2018-19 academic year.
 - 26 member organizations report 134,106 of those women were initiated reflecting a 92.7 percent retention rate, which is below last year's retention rate of 94 percent.
- 24 member organizations reported 30,341 initiated members resigned from our organizations.
- 21 member organizations report 62,872 collegiate women graduated from college in the 2018-19 academic year.

Academic Success – Grade Point Average (GPA)

- 11 member organizations report the average new member GPA for fall 2018 was 3.13, down 2.9 percent; 7 member organizations report the average new member GPA for spring 2019 was 3.24, up .62 percent.
- 16 member organizations report the average initiated member GPA for fall 2018 was 3.29; 10 member organizations report the average initiated member GPA for spring 2019 was 3.31. Both are consistent with last year.

Scholarships and Financial Assistance

- 16 member organizations report a total of \$4,644,237 in scholarships awarded to members.

Philanthropy and Volunteering

- 13 member organizations report a total of \$17,226,162 raised for inter/national philanthropy activity.
 - 13 member organizations report a total of \$14,417,411 raised among collegiate members for their inter/national philanthropies.
 - 8 member organizations report a total of \$2,808,751 raised among alumnae members for their inter/national philanthropies.
- 14 member organizations report a total of 1,903,932 hours volunteered for inter/national service activity.
 - 14 member organizations report collegiate members volunteered a total of 1,856,094 hours with our inter/national partners.
 - 5 member organizations report alumnae members volunteered a total of 47,838 hours with our inter/national partners.
