

About Something of Value:

Something of Value is an initiative solely of the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) with support from the NPC Foundation. The recently redesigned program is a full-day interactive community building experience that fosters connection, empowerment and influence across College Panhellenic communities in order to address cultural norms that can get in the way of members' health and safety.



Something of Value advances the following three objectives:

Empower	Connect	Influence
Empower women to take personal responsibility for the culture of their community.	Foster deep interfraternal connections that prepare women to collaborate on shared goals.	Equip women to use their influence to create the culture they want for their community.

Note: Applications for Something of Value will be accepted on a rolling basis, but it is recommended this program should be hosted at the beginning of a term or immediate after new College Panhellenic officers begin their terms. NPC does not recommend this program be hosted in late spring or at the end of an officer term.

Prior to Applying:

- 1. Confirm all College Panhellenic member chapters are interested in participating in this program through an affirmative vote at a College Panhellenic meeting.
- 2. Review the detailed program overview, which can be found at npcwomen.org/programs/something-of-value.
- 3. Confirm your College Panhellenic budget can support the program fee and additional costs associated with the program. Funds are due when the application is submitted.
- 4. Identify three dates, at the beginning of a term, this program could be hosted.
